Major General. Dr. Yotin Chinvarun is a Neurologist and a Specialist in Epilepsy, Sleep disorder, and Neuroimaging at the Neurology Division, Phramongkutklao Royal Army Hospital (PMK), Bangkok, Thailand. He is also Head of the Comprehensive Epilepsy and Sleep Disorder Program at the same institution and running an epilepsy and sleep fellowship program.

Dr Chinvarun was a Epilepsy fellow at Austin & Repatriation Medical Center, Melbourne, Australia. He was awarded his Ph.D. in Neurology from the University of Melbourne, Australia. He was a pioneer settling up epilepsy surgery, VNS, deep brain stimulation in epilepsy and new AEDs trial in Thailand. He worked at Epilepsy centre at Chulalongkorn University, between 1998 to 2000 and currently at the PMK hospital. He also has expertise in functional neuroimaging, SPECT, PET brain, EEG source localization and EEG-fMRI.

He also holds numerous positions in academia and with professional societies – he is currently, among others, President of Society of Sleep Neurology Association and President of the Brain foundation Thailand. He worked as committee in ILAE imaging task force (2018-Present). He has authored various research articles in prestigious local and international peer-reviewed journals. Also, he worked affiliated research with the Faculty of Bio-engineering, Toronto university. He had been worked as reviewer of *Epilepsia*, *Epilepsia open*, *Epileptic disorders* and *Epilepsy & Behavior Journal*.
